Advent

Our Advent Services this year will take place weekly on Wednesdays from November 30th - December 21st at 6:30 pm. We will celebrate Christmas Eve with one service also at 6:30 pm, and Christmas Day at 9:30 am.

Our Community Care Pastor, Steve Roth, has prepared a daily devotion for this season to go with our services and prepare our hearts for Christmas. The season of Advent is observed during the four Sundays before Christmas. The word Advent comes from the Latin Ad venire, which means "to come to." Although this season is not found in the Bible, its meaning is found throughout Scripture. Prepare the way for the Lord – He is coming!

COME is used as an action verb in a variety of ways in Scripture. It is used to show us how God comes to us, and how we come to God. It is used to encourage someone to move toward something or someone; other times it is used as a charge or invitation that requires an active and sometimes immediate response. In and of ourselves we have no power to even come to God – or even believe in Him. But because of God's grace, He offers us invitations to respond to His grace by faith.

During this Advent Season, we want to remind ourselves of what it means "to come to." The devotions found during the first and third week all correspond with Scriptures that tell us how God has come to us. The devotions found in weeks two and four tells us how we are to come to Him. Someone once said, "When grace knocks on your door, let faith answer."

At the start of each week I have included a Hymn of the Week (that corresponds to the theme). Following the hymn you will find information on the Advent Candle, Advent thoughts, and an Advent Activity. All of this can assist the reader in preparing for Christmas.

Christ has come! Christ is here! Christ is coming again! May the Lord bless your Christmas.


CHRISTMAS PROGRAM December 18, 9:30 AM

Loving Liberia Update

The people in Liberia are very determined in building infrastructure that allows them to have a better life. The people of the District of Zarflahn in River Cess County built this bridge by raising the money among themselves. Some people bought steel, others bought cement, and others bought wood and other items to build this footbridge that is rated for foot traffic and motor scooters.


The local people came together and built the bridge themselves and the national government sent an engineer to inspect the bridge when it was completed. This bridge is the first of four bridges that will need to be constructed to get back to Perry's village in Gayes Zahn Town, River Cess.



Can you imagine getting your neighbors together and building the bridge or making things happen that will make life better for all? Well, isn't that neighboring? Doing things together with your neighbors to make life better for all.

The bridge may not look like much but it is a work of art when you see all the people of the local villages smile and share their excitement of having a better life. Before the bridge was built, you had to walk across a log to get from one side

to the other side of the river. This is a big deal for the people in Perry's home country and having two Lutheran schools with 257 children is a big deal for the country and the kingdom of Jesus. Peoples' lives are being changed with sharing the gospel of Jesus in our schools. "Won't you be my neighbor?" was what Mr. Rogers used to say. Let's make some new neighbors every day. Pastor Doug said this Sunday, November 20: "Let's Make Easter Great Again." We are MEGA Christians working for the king and his kingdom.
