Mission of the Month: A Year's Reflection

We have had an incredible year supporting ministries and organizations both locally and internationally. Here's a reflection on the year just passed.

February: We partnered with Metroplex Women's Clinic and provided items for gift baskets supporting mothers facing unexpected pregnancies.

March: We had many members volunteer in a family/community outreach Easter event.

April: We supported our local healthcare workers by arranging and delivering gift bags with notes of appreciation to Texas Health Arlington Memorial Hospital.

May: Donations poured in and we surpassed our mission goal participating in World Vision's Global 6K for Water, helping provide communities with clean water and sanitation.

June: We blessed SafeHaven with supplies helping provide services to local domestic violence victims.

July: More supplies and monetary support were provided to Arlington Life Shelter, assisting locals impacted by homelessness create a path to self-sufficiency.

September: We welcomed new GLEE

families to our school by serving them take-home pizzas and welcome bags introducing them to our church.

October: We threw a baby shower for the women who participated in our Embrace Grace group - in this group parents experiencing unplanned pregnancies were able to connect with our church members and experience renewed hope in Christ.

November: Grace members donated and supported 39 students to attend Perry Smith's schools for the year. Loving Liberia is changing the lives of children and their families as the children learn about Jesus and have a Christian education so they can have a better life.

December: Lutheran Braille Workers help people touch the promises of Jesus year-round, but this last month we renewed our call for volunteers and donated to continue supporting this ministry.

Mission of the Month: Souper Bowl of Caring

The Souper Bowl of Caring empowers and unites communities to tackle hunger using the energy of the Big Super Bowl Football Game. Its vision is to transform the Big Game into a nationwide movement inspiring people to give locally and make a collective impact on hunger. People collect

monetary and canned soup donations traditionally during the weeks leading up to and after Super Bowl Sunday. All of the money and food is then given directly to local charities of the group's choice, which for us will be Arlington Charities.

Canned soup will be collected in January and February, ending on Super Bowl Sunday, February 13, 2022. Any monetary donations will be used to buy soup. Thrivent Financial will also supplement this soup drive.
