Loving Liberia has been blessed this past year with many accomplishments: building a temporary school building in River Cess (Perry's home village), beginning

construction on bathrooms adjacent to the temporary building, and nearing completion of fence around the school in Monrovia. Now, we are going to have our first real computer classes at our Monrovia campus. Our goal is to have 20 laptop computers by the end of January with each computer costing \$125. These laptops are refurbished and will meet the needs of our students.

On Sunday January 8th, we will be having one Bible class at Grace so we can share with you what God is doing and invite you on our journey to purchase new, refurbished laptop computers. Thank you for your support and we want to make sure we are transparent on how the funds are being spent to support 257 students in our two schools.

- 2. Type (833)630-9900 in the send to line
- 3. Type GRACELC in the message line.
- 4. Press to send message.

Almost immediately you will receive a message back thanking you for your generosity.

- 6. This takes you to the page where you will see our church logo.
- 7. You have the option to make a gift to the church's ministries.
- 8. You can insert the dollar amount of the gift.
- 9. You can choose the frequency of the gift (one-time gift or recurring gifts).
- 10. Choose the fund type (tithes, etc.).
- 11. Click Next.
- 12. You will be able to confirm the details you just chose, then add your credit card or bank account information, and it can be stored for you or not, as you desire.
- 13. Check the box to authorize the transaction.
- 14. Press GIVE, and you are done.


