Who is My Neighbor?

The world is shrinking. Have you noticed?

I'm not saying the world is getting physically smaller, but think about it: in an instant, thanks to technological advances, you can Skype (or use other forms of social media) with a friend on the other side of the planet. We carry phones that allow people to reach us virtually anytime, anywhere. With a few clicks on a keyboard, we have immediate access to all sorts of information. With email, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Pinterest, Instagram, TumbIr, Blogger, and...well...any number of other social media platforms, we are able to keep up-to-date with all the latest happenings in the lives of our family and friends.

Here's why it matters...

With all of these connections, you have more potential to share Jesus with the world than any generation in history. But in order to share Jesus, we must be willing to be present in the lives of people who aren't like us.

It's easy to spend time with people who are like you–people who have the same interests, backgrounds, beliefs, etc. But if we are going to take the love of Christ to people who don't know Him, we will have to invest in people who don't share our beliefs about God. It will require loving someone who is not like you.

After all, Jesus tells us in Matthew 22:37-39 (NLT), "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself." Notice: there is no qualification to only love people who believe like you, live like you, attend the same school as you, work in the same field as you, etc. Jesus simply tells us to 'love God, and love our neighbors.'

Maybe the best way to love God is to simply love who God loves... And who does God love? "God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16, NLT).

So, how will you love your neighbors this week? This month? Put it into Practice:

1. Pick one person—a family member, person your age, workmate or someone else in your life. Pray for that person each day for the next week. Write their name on a notecard or post-it note, and put it where you will see it each day. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal ways you can share Christ's love with that person.

2. Consider how you can share Christ's love in each of these ways: spiritually, relationally, physically, intellectually or financially. This month, make it a practice to go out of your way every day to share Christ's love with someone.

ESL Classes Ministry

Our first English as a Second Language Classes semester has ended just last week - it was a great year! God showed his love and care for each one of the students during the year through each of our weekly volunteers. We served and reached out to around 80 people from our community in our first year. Yay God! God did marvelous things through this ministry, and we are excited to see what God also has in store for us in our next semester.

Classes will resume Wednesday September 6, 2023, and go on until the middle of May 2024. We follow the Arlington ISD Calendar for our Holidays during the year. People meet on Wednesdays from 6:30-8:00 pm. Childcare is also provided.

The ESL program has created the opportunity to do mission outreach. A Spanish Bible study has started including some of our ESL students, and an early communion class also started with some of their kids.

We appreciate all the teachers' support, volunteers, and of course the support and prayers of all of you. As we get ready for a new ESL year next fall, we would like to request your prayers and to look into the opportunity of serving our community. It doesn't have to be a weekly commitment; there are plenty of options to serve. Knowing the Spanish language is also not necessary to help with this ministry. Some examples of how you could serve are listed below:
