

#### Update from the Del Cristos

To our Family of Faith at Grace,

Many of you may know, but I (Jenna) want to give an update for everyone on what the future holds for Richie and me, and what it means for our roles in this community of faith.

Richie has been called to and pursuing a flying career for the past 4+ years. In March of this year, his dreams finally 'took off' and he was hired to become a C-5 Pilot with the Air Force Reserves! ## Thanksgiving Turkeys, Pork Loins, and Sausage

We are smoking whole turkeys (avg 10-12 lbs.), turkey breast (avg 6-8 lbs.), whole or half pork loins, and sausage (mild 14 ounce or spicy 12 ounce) on Wednesday, November 22.

Orders will need to be pre-paid at \$40.00 per whole turkey, \$35.00 for the turkey breast, \$40.00 for whole pork loin, \$20.00 for a half pork loin, and \$8.00 per ring of sausage or 2 for \$15.00. 
