First Reading Acts 16:9-15

- 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night: a man of Macedonia was standing there, urging him and saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us."
- 10 And when Paul had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go on into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.
- 11 So, setting sail from Troas, we made a direct voyage to Samothrace, and the following day to Neapolis,
- 12 and from there to Philippi, which is a leading city of the district of Macedonia and a Roman colony. We remained in this city some days.
- 13 And on the Sabbath day we went outside the gate to the riverside, where we supposed there was a place of prayer, and we sat down and spoke to the women who had come together.
- 14 One who heard us was a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God. The Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul.
- 15 And after she was baptized, and her household as well, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.
- P: This is the Word of the Lord.
- C: Thanks be to God.

Epistle Reading

15 For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints,

Ephesians 1:15-23

- 16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers,
- 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him,
- 18 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints,
- 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might
- 20 that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places,
- 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.
- 22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church,
- 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.

Gospel Reading: John 16:22–33

- 22 So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you.
- 23 In that day you will ask nothing of me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you.
- 24 Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.
- 25 "I have said these things to you in figures of speech. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figures of speech but will tell you plainly about the Father.
- 26 In that day you will ask in my name, and I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf;
- 27 for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.
- 28 I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father."
- 29 His disciples said, "Ah, now you are speaking plainly and not using figurative speech!
- 30 Now we know that you know all things and do not need anyone to question you; this is why we believe that you came from God."
- 31 Jesus answered them, "Do you now believe?

- 32 Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with me.
- 33 I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."
