Confession and Absolution

(The following is taken from Martin Luther's booklet, "A Simple Way to Pray.")

- P: Lord, You taught us to pray, "forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors."
- C: DEAR LORD GOD, FATHER, DO NOT CALL US INTO JUDGMENT, FOR IN YOUR PRESENCE NO ONE IS RIGHTEOUS. PLEASE DO NOT CONDEMN US FOR BEING UNGRATEFUL FOR ALL OF YOUR UNSPEAKABLE GOODNESS – BOTH SPIRITUAL AND PHYSICAL – AND FOR OUR DAILY BLUNDERS AND SINS – WHICH ARE MORE THAN WE KNOW OR MARK.
- P: Furthermore, do not consider how good or bad we have been, but look upon us with Your infinite compassion, bestowed upon us by Christ, Your beloved Son.
- C: FORGIVE ALSO ALL OUR ENEMIES AND ALL THOSE WHO HAVE HARMED US OR DONE US AN INJUSTICE, EVEN AS WE FORGIVE THEM FROM THE HEART.
- P: By the mercy of God, we are redeemed by Jesus Christ, and in Him we are forgiven. Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: AMEN.
