

- 47 When evening came, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and he was alone on land.
- 48 He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. About the fourth watch of the night he went out to them, walking on the lake. He was about to pass by them,
- 49 but when they saw him walking on the lake, they thought he was a ghost. They cried out,
- 50 because they all saw him and were terrified.
- 51 Immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." Then he climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. They were completely amazed,
- 52 for they had not understood about the loaves; their hearts were hardened.

Pushpay

- 1. Use your cell phone text messaging feature.
- 2. Type (833) 630-9900 in the send to line
- 3. Type GRACELC in the message line.
- Press to send message. Almost immediately you will receive a message back thanking you for your generosity.
- 5. Click the link shown in the message.
- 6. This takes you to the page where you will see our church logo.
- You have the option to make a gift to the church's ministries.
- 8. You can insert the dollar amount of the gift.
- 9. You can choose the frequency of the gift (one-time gift or recurring gifts).
- 10. Choose the fund type (tithes, etc.).
- 11. Click Next.
- 12. You will be able to confirm the details you just chose, then add your credit card or bank account information, and it can be stored for you or not, as you desire.
- 13. Check the box to authorize the transaction.
- 14. Press GIVE, and you are done.
