Pushpay Instructions

- 1. Use your cell phone text messaging feature.
- 2. Type **77977** in the send to line.
- 3. Type **GRACELC** in the message line.
- 4. Press to send message.
- Almost immediately you will receive a message back thanking you for your generosity.
- 5. Click the link shown in the message.
- 6. This takes you to the page where you will see our church logo.
- 7. You have the option to make a gift to the church's ministries.
- 8. You can insert the dollar amount of the gift.
- 9. You can choose the frequency of the gift (one-time gift or reoccurring gifts).
- 10. Choose the fund type (tithes, etc.).
- 11. Click Next.
- 12. You will be able to confirm the details you just chose, then add your credit card or bank account information, and it can be stored for you or not, as you desire.
- 13. Check the box to authorize the transaction.
- 14. Press GIVE, and you are done. 2


Senior Support Network & Zoom Book Club




