Paying It Back — and Forward

During the pandemic, acts of kindness seemed especially meaningful. Last spring, as Covid-19 hit Native American communities particularly hard, an interesting transatlantic outreach occurred. Donations from Ireland began appearing in a relief fund for Navajo and Hopi families, leading administrators to suspect the account had been hacked. Then they realized a cross-generational payback was underway.

In 1847, Choctaw Tribe members sent \$170 overseas to Ireland to help with Potato Famine relief. That generosity was never forgotten, and by May 2020, people in Ireland had contributed more than \$4 million toward pandemic assistance for relatives of people who'd helped their ancestors. Many donors included an Irish proverb meaning "In each other's shadows the people live."

The concept of paying it forward dates back to a 1784 letter by Benjamin Franklin. It also echoes Jesus' Golden Rule: "Do to others as you would have them do to you" (Luke 6:31). How might you live out this practice today?

Great causes inspire generous responses

hile the chilling shadow of a pandemic enveloped the world in 2020, the Holy Spirit shined a light on Liberia through one man who infected a small group of volunteers and donors with a contagious spirit to bring hope to a nation, a continent and perhaps the entire world. That man is Perry Geevon Smith. The nation is Liberia, a republic established with Christian principles in 1847 and modeled after many of the values of the founders of the United States of America. The cause is the support of two Christian schools founded ten and five years ago respectively, along with a measure of humanitarian aid and medical support to the staff and families.

2020 - Faithfulness and Faith

- Despite the postponed school openings due to Covid-19, generous donors provided funds sufficient to pay on the lease and remodel the Monrovia school, pay the school teachers and staff, and provide uniforms and supplies to have a joyous resumption of classes in early 2021.
- A full color brochure was developed and printed
- Our 501(c)(3) application was approved
- A beautiful logo and web site, www.lovingliberia.com was created
- A Director of Development position was proposed


2021 - Goals, Vision and Plans

- To add sufficient monthly donors @ \$30.00 a month to sponsor each child for a total operating budget of \$79,200.
- To acquire a 400-acre parcel in River Cess for the purpose of establishing a modern Christian school, student boarding facilities and a self-sustaining Christian community. Cost per acre surveyed, probated and with corner stones is: \$92.00.
- To begin construction on a school and community center to house students in River Cess. A preliminary concept drawing has been submitted.
- To increase enrollment by 10% in both River Cess and Monrovia
- To be able to respond to more humanitarian and health needs.
- To attract a minimum of 100 new donors, four donor organizations, two grants, and one major business sponsorship

We will continue this month with online Bible Studies.
