TIME

I have been interested in how the bible describes time, and noticing how others discuss their understanding of time. It is very clear how time is described in the creation of God from the beginning as described in:

Genesis 1:14 "And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark seasons and days and years, and let them be lights in the expanse of the sky to give light on the earth."

And again in Genesis 1:3-8 a "day" is defined in more detail: "God said, "Let there be light." and there was light. God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from darkness. God called the light "day", and the darkness he called "night."

## The following are several descriptions of time in the Bible:

2 Peter 3:8 "But do not forget this one thing, dear friends. With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand year are like a day."

James 4:1 "Why do you not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a **mist** that appears for a little while and then vanishes"

Exodus 20:12 "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may **live long** in this land the Lord your God is giving you."

Revelation 22:5 (On our New Earth) "There will be no more nights. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light." and "they will reign for **ever** and **ever**, on the New Earth."

## Time as we know it will END:

[But there will be a **NEW** time that will **God's Time**]

Revelations 22:1 "Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and the Lord down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the Tree of Life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month."

### I will close with words from 2 Peter 3:8-9&17-18

But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With Lord a day is like a thousands years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. Therefore, dear friends, since you already know this, be on your guard so that you may not be carried away by the error of lawless men and fall from your secure position. 


