Loving Liberia Update (Perry Geevon Smith Lutheran Schools):

Dear friends at Grace,

Thank you for your support of Perry's schools in Liberia and what awesome ministry is being done in the name of our Lord Jesus. Children are receiving a quality education and daily hearing the message of a God of love who sent his one and only Son to save us from our sins.

Where we were:

Last year we became a 501 (c)(3) which means we are classified as a non-profit by the IRS. All gifts given to support Perry's schools are tax deductible. Also last year, we developed and launched a new website for Perry's schools (www.lovingliberia.com).

Where we are:

God has led us to find a global ministry called Enactus that will help us with social media and working with our website to reach more people. Enactus is a worldwide organization that works with non-profits to help with global ministry in support of Christianity.

We are working on updating the website with student's profiles and pictures so anyone around the world who has a heart to sponsor a child for \$360 a year (\$30 a month) can become part of the ministry. Hopefully by May of this year this feature will be added to our website with the help of Enactus.

Where we are going:

Perry will be mailing out over 50 letters in late April to contacts he has throughout the United States sharing the progress of his ministry and inviting others to become part of the ministry through prayer and financial support and for anyone who feels led by the Lord to become a board member of his organization.

We recently received a challenge grant of \$5,000 to help us raise money towards the purchase of 100 acres of land for the new school in River Cess. Very soon we will launch a Go Fund Me Page for matching funds to purchase 100 acres in River Cess County in Liberia where Perry's original school is. Perry's original building lasted for ten years before it was no longer in good enough shape to house students. Perry's school in River Cess in currently meeting in a church in his home town.

Perry will be traveling to Liberia in late May or early June to meet with county officials to purchase land and work on building permits. Plans will be drawn up in the near future for a 40 acre campus with buildings and how we can farm the other 60 acres to help generate revenue for the school through growing crops.

What you can do:

- 1. Please continue to pray for Perry's schools that we can reach as many people as possible with the good news of Jesus.
- 2. Please let others know of this ministry and invite them to become a sponsor for a child.
- 3. Please consider being a board member or an advisory to the board.
- 4. Volunteer from time to time when the call is heard.


