Midweek of Lent 5 (April 6): Pontius Pilate, John 19:1–16


Soup and Salad Meal - hosted by GLEE Palm Sunday (April 10): The Disciples, John 12:12–19

NEW Outreach Zumba


We are moving forward in outreach to the Hispanic community around us through some new ministry partnerships!

God of love - for, with and in us

An ancient heresy — that the God of the Old Testament was a God of judgment and wrath, while the God of the New Testament is a God of grace and love — still persists a bit. Yet God is the same God, with the same characteristics, throughout time. Way back in Genesis 3, God graciously sewed garments to clothe humans, although they had disobeyed him. And even in the Gospels, God's anger was evident through Jesus' response to temple moneychangers cheating the poor.

God always works for life and goodness in all things. Sometimes people

misunderstand God's ways; sometimes God, like a human parent, uses "tough love." Mick Brooks writes: "The Old Testament is God for us, the time of Christ is God with us, and the age of the Holy Spirit is God in us" (Every Day With Jesus, Sept/Oct 2020). That may be a bit simplistic, but it's a good reminder that while God's ways of interacting with us vary, he — the God of Love — does not. 3. Type GRACELC in the

- 1. Use your cell phone text messaging feature.
- 2. Type (833)630-9900 in the send to line
 - message line.
- 4. Press to send message. Almost immediately you will receive a message back thanking you for your generosity.
- 5. Click the link shown in the message.
- 6. This takes you to the page where you will see our church logo.
- 7. You have the option to make a gift to the church's ministries.
- 8. You can insert the dollar amount of the gift.
- 9. You can choose the frequency of the gift (one-time gift or recurring gifts).
- 10. Choose the fund type (tithes, etc.).
- 11. Click Next.
- 12. You will be able to confirm the details you just chose, then add your credit card or bank account information, and it can be stored for you or not, as you desire.
- 13. Check the box to authorize the transaction.
- 14. Press GIVE, and you are done.


