*Paper Connection Cards are not going away! This will just be another way you can let us know when you're here/submit prayer requests, etc.




Engage Community Update

Loving Liberia Update

Perry Geevon Smith Lutheran School in Monrovia Soccer Team is well known for its athletics. Our school provides the uniforms for the children.

Because of the war, some of the older children you see on the soccer team are in 5th-7th grade. The soccer season has just started and Perry's team has three wins, one tie and one loss.





Easter was celebrated at Perry Geevon Smith Lutheran School in Monrovia with this child holding her Easter egg. Loving Liberia provides an all-around education for children that is free. We share the joy of knowing Jesus to the underserved in Monrovia. We live out our motto: Learning Today to Build a Better Tomorrow.

We are sending Perry to Liberia in May to help support his schools with building a fence around the Monrovia school for better security and to qualify us for government subsidy. Perry will also be visiting our campus in River Cess where we will finalize the deed for 40 acres to eventually build a new school for children in the interior of the country.


