Dear Family of Faith @ Grace Lutheran: Below are some deep convictions which the Holy Spirit has been impressing upon me for the past few years. I have shared them with our Elders, Board of Directors, and our Ministry Team. Excellence in All Things

- 1... I believe God is wanting to breathe a fresh wind on our family of faith through a season of coming together. (Acts 2:2)
- 2... I believe he is calling us to the following actions:

Bow down in humility (Proverbs 11:2; 15:33; Psalm 95:6; Philippians 2:5-8) Look up in gratitude (Isaiah 60:3-4; Matthew 14:19)

Lean in to Him and one another in fellowship (Proverbs 3:5; 1 John 1:3) Reach out with generosity and mission focus (2 Corinthians 8:1-3)

- 3... I believe we will learn to do these things best as we worship together in unity. One message, one service, one time of gathering together in worship and study so God's people can be deployed to the community of Arlington and beyond (Ephesians 4:3-5).
- 4... I believe it is time to be bold as a lion (Proverbs 28:1) in honoring God with Sabbath excellence in all we are and do including worship, facilities, and training (Psalm 8).
- 5... I believe we are all "broken people helping heal what is broken". This is not optional, marginal or "what staff people do". It is core to every believer in this family of faith (Psalm 34:18).
- 6... I believe it is time for creating greater urgency in order to allow God the space to show up for such a time as this (Esther 4:14).
- 7... I believe that through this season he will draw others to himself as he has always done when his glory is revealed to the dying world (Luke 10:21).


