





Loving Liberia has officially acquired two acres of land in Monrovia, Liberia. This has been a long process, because many deed holders don't have adequate records to prove they are the rightful owners. We are very grateful to Change Agent Network for assisting us in the process. We will begin construction before Christmas on building three classrooms: one for the workers to live in, the second classroom will be to store materials, and the third classroom will be for cooking. Having the workers onsite will help us keep costs down and aid in the building process.



When we get close to finishing the school, the three classrooms will have a new roof put on them and we will transition to finish the school. We all at Loving Liberia thank you for your prayers and support in helping children know Jesus and having an excellent Christian education to further impact the literacy of Liberia. We all pray that you have a Christ-filled New Year.


