- December 28 Living the "Even If" Life



Adult Bible Classes Resume


During September and October we took a pause to all study the book of Joshua together. On Sunday, November 2, regular adult Bible classes will resume at 10:45 each week.

Dr. Kleinig has been a professor at Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, Indiana, and Australian Lutheran College. He is also the author of the Hebrews and Leviticus Commentaries in the Concordia Commentaries series. 



WOVEN

Handicrafts can spark appreciation for simple items. Weave this basket as a gift.



What you need:

- Paper plate
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Yarn (different colors)

What you do:

- In the center of the plate, trace something round. Draw 9 lines (evenly spaced) from the circle to the plate's edge.
- Cut along each line, stopping at the center circle. Trim more of the plate off so the cuts make a gradual V shape.
- Fold the plate's sides upward to form basket sides. Keep these upright as you weave a bowl-shaped basket.
- Begin weaving a length of yarn at the circle's base. Hold the end of the yarn in place as you spread the length over and under each side of the plate.
- Switch colors to make a pattern. Keep the yarn tight as you weave up the sides.
- 6. To finish, bend down any remaining paper. Leave a tail of yarn and tuck it under a woven portion. Share your craft with a friend!



Holy Smokers Are Smoking AGAIN!



We are smoking whole turkeys (average 10-12 lbs.), turkey breast (average 6-8 lbs.), whole or half pork loins, and sausage (mild 14 ounce or spicy 12 ounce) on Wednesday, November 26.

Orders will need to be pre-paid at \$40.00 per whole turkey, \$35.00 for the turkey breast, \$40.00 for whole pork loin, \$20.00 for a half pork loin, and \$8.00 per ring of sausage or 2 for \$15.00.

Deadline to sign up for turkeys, pork loins and sausage will be after church service on Sunday, November 23.
