Loving Liberia Update

We are glad to report that we have begun building our new school in Monrovia, Liberia after some mishaps with the original survey of the land. When the survey was completed to purchase two acres of land we only received one and half acres of land. Our point person in Liberia was not yet in the country when the survey was done and when he arrived in Liberia, he noticed the shortage of land. It has taken nine months to complete the process of going through all the government regulations to have the property resurveyed and restart the building of the new school and restart the building of the new school.

Our school will have 12 classrooms, cafeteria, science lab, computer lab, and a library which can house up to 420 children from prekindergarten to 12th grade.

We wish to thank all of you for your prayers, continued support and how this new school will make a difference in the lives of God's children in Liberia.

Our school will have a soft opening in January 2026 with the help of Change Agent Network who will operate the school on our behalf. God has provided another Christian organization to step in run the school.

We have raised \$105,396 towards our goal of \$115,667. Would you consider a gift in December to help us raise the remaining funds to finish our school? 


